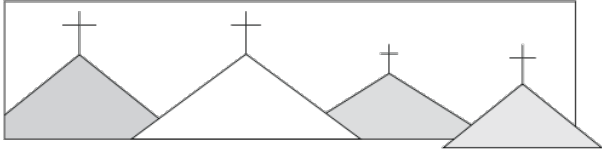

Small Church Connection holds to the following values:

1. We believe in the value of the small church

The small church has value in and of itself. While most of the attention is paid to large churches, the small church is making a powerful impact on Canadian church life.

2. We believe in the centrality of Jesus Christ in the life of the church.

In the Bible the church is described as a body, a building and a bride. Jesus is the head of that body, the corner stone of the building and the bridegroom waiting for his bride. Every church needs to measure its value by its relationship to Jesus and that relationship is vital to the small church.

3. We believe in the uniqueness of each and every church.

Every church needs to discover its own unique place in the Canadian Church Mosaic. Every church has its own culture, community and challenges and as such each church must discover the unique way in which God wants it to function within that context.

4. We believe in the importance of leadership.

A church will never move beyond the level of its leadership. A strong, united, growing leadership is the greatest asset that any church can have.

5. We believe in the Great Commission's call to produce disciples.

The commission that Jesus gave to his disciples in Matthew 28:19, 20 is still binding on the church today. At the heart of that commission is the call to make disciples. The challenge to bring people from the point of first interest in the gospel to the point at which they are fully functioning followers of Jesus Christ is still the heart of what the church is called to do.

6. We believe that financial considerations should not determine our availability to churches

Small churches constantly operate under financial restraints. This greatly limits the resources that are available to them. With this in mind we are committed to raising additional funds from sources other than the churches which we serve so that we can be available to everyone regardless of their ability to pay for our services.

Small Church Connections believes that:

- there is one God, eternally exists in three Persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit. God alone is Creator, Preserver and Ruler of all things visible and invisible.
- Jesus Christ was conceived by the Holy Spirit, was born of the virgin Mary, was fully God and fully human existing in one person and was without sin. We believe in His substitutionary sacrifice, His bodily resurrection, His ascension, His present life as Lord of all, High Priest and Advocate, and His personal return in power and glory.
- the Holy Spirit indwells all believers, empowers them for godly living, and equips them for service and witness.
- the Scriptures of the Old and New Testament are inspired by God, without error in the original documents, completely trustworthy and the only supreme authority in all matters of Christian faith and practice.
- each member of the human race is fallen, sinful and lost; that salvation is possible only through the shed blood of Jesus Christ and is received on the basis of faith alone apart from works and is characterized by regeneration by the Holy Spirit.
- the one, universal Church is the body of Christ, composed of all true believers.
- there will be a bodily resurrection of the just and the unjust, the everlasting blessedness of the saved and the everlasting punishment of the lost.
